We've had a strange end to the year but look at all the fun we had before that and all the learning we did.

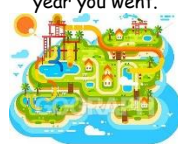


Design Challenge!

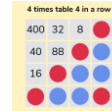
You are going to design a holiday resort which suits your whole family!

Have a look on a map and decide exactly where your resort will be. You could find out more about the climate (weather) in this country so that you would know what clothes to take depending on what time of year you went.



Maths: Multiplication 4 in a row



Step 1: Each player needs a set of coloured counters or different coins

Step 2: Make a grid containing the answers to the times table being worked on and a set of cards (or small pieces of paper) with the multiplication questions e.g. 7x4

Step 3: Each player takes it in turn to pick a card, work out the answer and cover the answer with their counter.

The first player to cover 4 in a row is the winner.

Health and Wellbeing:
